## **Qualifications and experience:**

- Education: Master or Bachelor of Science in **biology** (ecology, biodiversity conservation) and/or forestry and/or environment.
- Working experience with international NGOs and/or Lao NPA specialised in Rural development and/or NTFP value chains and/or Biodiversity conservation and/or Environment protection.
- Experience and knowledge in participatory community development, NTFP and environment conservation.
- Ability to work in partnership with local authorities, international & Lao partners and ethnic minorities.
- Self-organization, autonomy and good communication skills.
- Ability to undertake travel to remote villages frequently.
- Knowledge of ethnic languages (Khmu, Akha, Hmong), and English and/or French would be an asset
- Good knowledge of common computer applications: Windows, Excel, Word.
- Women are encouraged to apply.

## Main responsibilities:

- Work with local government staff and local communities, following participatory approach with respect for the environment, local cultures and gender equality, to support NTFP value chains and environment conservation.
- Strengthen the Village Natural Resource Management Committees and Forest units: capacity building, facilitate the creation of rules, facilitate the update of the land-use plans.
- Support to the **collective management and processing of key NTFP** (bitter bamboo, broom grass, red mushroom), support the **building of NTFP dryers**, and participate in the **strengthening of the NTFP value chains** (consultations middlemen-producers, organisation of technical exchanges).
- Set up the Biodiversity Awareness Campaign: sessions at schools, work with students' group, organisation of village biodiversity events.
- Collect data, write quality activity reports, provide analysis & recommandations to improve the action.
- Coordinate with others project components and with local authorities.

<u>Work location:</u> Xay District, Oudomxay Province, with frequent travels to -and stays in- the 50 targeted villages in Beng, La and Xay Districts.
