Technician on Water access and management (Lao National) for its Project on Integrated rural development in Beng, La and Xay districts, Oudomxay province

Qualifications and experience:

- Education: Master or Bachelor of Science in water resource management and/or irrigation and/or environment and/or engineering.
- Working experience with international NGOs and/or Lao NPA specialised in water supply & sanitation and/or rural development projects and/or environment protection.
- Experience and knowledge in participatory community development, in water supply and/or watershed management and/or climate change issues.
- Ability to design water supply schemes (technical drawings, calculation of the water needs and flows, establishments of the bills of quantities, organisation and overview of all the construction steps)
- Ability to work in partnership with local authorities, international & Lao partners, with ethnic minorities. Ability to undertake travels to remote villages frequently.
- Self-organization, autonomy and good communication skills.
- Knowledge of ethnic languages (Khmu, Akha, Hmong) and of English and/or French is an asset.
- Good knowledge of common computer applications: Windows, Excel, Word.
- Women are encouraged to apply.

Main responsibilities:

- Work with local government staff and local communities, following participatory approach with respect for the environment, local cultures and gender equality, to improve the water access in communities and watershed governance at territory level.
- Facilitate consultations with communities to define their needs in terms of water access infrastructures, and establish the technical design of the water supply schemes.
- Work with Village Water Committees: facilitate the design of the rules, capacity building, monitoring.
- Facilitate a concertation process with villagers to improve the management of the water resources at the scale of a pilot river bassin. Support the communities to set up pilot actions to reduce their vulnerability to drought and floods.
- Collect data, write quality activity reports, provide analysis & recommandations to improve the action.
- Coordinate with others project components and with local authorities.
- Contribute to project representation.

<u>Work location:</u> Xay District, Oudomxay Province, with frequent travels to -and stays in- the 50 targeted villages in Beng, La and Xay Districts.
