In Laos, PCF is working with local partner organisations to create safe environments for primary school girls and boys to advance quality learning in the subjects of the Lao language, environmental education and to develop green and clean schools in partnership with teachers and local communities.

Short-term consultancy: Training on Adaptive Leadership and Strategic Staff Development | Vang Vieng, Laos | 30 March - 03 April 2026

1. Training Objective and Participants

PCF provides funding to local organisations and aims at strengthening their staff capacities and skills to achieve the programme outcomes. To support local partner organisations we would like to offer a training for project managers and field officers (including civil society organisation and government staff) on Adaptive Leadership and Strategic Staff Development. The training shall be practical, participatory and tailored to the specific needs and knowledge of the PCF partner organisations. It will focus on how leaders can effectively manage change, develop their teams, foster a motivated and high-performing staff, and treating staff development and motivation as core responsibilities.

The training shall enable participants to develop their competencies in leadership in education/adaptive leadership and staff development and motivation.

The consultancy will be tailored to the specific needs and knowledge of PCF's Laos partner organisations and developed in close collaboration with PCF HQ and the Laos Country Office.

The participants will be selected from PCF's partner organisations in Laos, which are a local NGOs of small size, and a government teacher training institution. A total of **15 - 20 participants** will attend.

2. Tentative Agenda

The agenda will be finalised jointly with the consultant, based on a needs assessment. It is expected to cover the following:

- Foundations of adaptive leadership (understanding principles, mindset shifts, and core competencies for leading in complex and changing environments);
- Diagnosing the system & mobilising change (tools and approaches for identifying and containing internal organisational stress; managing conflicts, etc.);
- Strategic staff development (aligning staff competencies with organisational goals; conducting needs assessment; designing effective personnel development plans);
- Fostering staff motivation and engagement (creating a culture of accountability and psychological safety; strategies for sustaining motivation and team resilience).

Note: The consultant is expected to provide the detailed content and agenda with potential sub-topics in the submitted technical offer.
