**Technician on livestock and agroecology (Lao National)  
 for its Project on Integrated rural development in Beng, La and Xay districts,  
 Oudomxay province**

### **Qualifications and experience:**

- Education: Master or Bachelor of Science in **veterinarian science** or **agriculture** (with a specialisation in plant productions, and/or livestock and/or agroecology).
- **Working experience with international NGOs** and/or Lao NPA specialised in Rural and/or Agricultural development.
- **Experience and knowledge in participatory community development.**
- **Primary experience on animal husbandry, forage cultivation, animal vaccination.**
- **Additional experience on agroecology, pesticides risks and alternatives to pesticides.**
- Ability to work in partnership with local authorities, international & Lao partners and ethnic minorities.
- Self-organization, autonomy and good communication skills.
- Ability to undertake travel to remote villages frequently.
- Knowledge of ethnic languages (Khmu, Akha, Hmong) would be an asset.
- Ability to understand and speak English and/or French is an asset.
- Good knowledge of common computer applications: Windows, Excel, Word.
- Women are encouraged to apply.

### **Main responsibilities:**

Note : The technician will primarily focus on livestock systems. However, additional responsibilities related to crop production and pesticide management may be assigned depending on project needs.

- **Work with local government staff and local communities**, following participatory approach with respect for the environment, local cultures and gender equality, to support farming and livestock development.
- Identify the needs in terms of **farming/livestock support** at village and household levels.
- **Prepare and facilitate technical trainings** to farmers on livestock raising (forage production, pasture management, animal health, vaccination), crop production (agroecological practices for corn, agroforestry systems, macadamia/coffee/tea cultivation), crop-livestock integration, alternatives to pesticides. Organise the **material support to farmers** (distribution of small material, seeds, seedlings). Organise and implement **animal vaccination campaigns**. **Technical monitoring of farmers**. **Organisation of technical exchanges** among farmers.
- Design and implement **pilot experiments with model farmers**.
- Collect data, write quality activity reports, provide analysis & recommendations to improve the action.
- Coordinate with others project components and with local authorities.

**Work location:** Xay District, Oudomxay Province, with frequent travels to -and stays in- the 50 targeted villages in Beng, La and Xay Districts.

**Duration: 21 Months.**
